SHOUT TO THE LORD

Psalm 100

This psalm is the grand finale (the doxology) of a series of Psalms (93-100) that glorify our Lord Jesus Christ, our Jehovah, as King of Kings!

I. MAKE A JOYFUL NOISE UNTO THE LORD (v. 1)

- 1. God wants you to worship Him in gladness!
- 2. You are worshipping God when you praise Him! (Ps 122:1)
- 3. This is a call for universal praise...no one is excluded.
- 4. We are called to praise Him, to worship and glorify Him!

II. SERVE THE LORD WITH GLADNESS (v. 2)

- 1. God does not want begrudged worship.
- 2. Reluctance steals the joy from both giver and receiver. (2 Cor 9:7)
- 3. The spirit of joy makes all the difference.
- 4. God is so good...He has given us all spiritual blessings.

III. THE LORD IS GOD (v. 3)

- 1. Many Christians say they believe it, but they do not act like it.
- 2. We owe Christ our worship because He is God; He made us!
- 3. If you belong to Jesus, He is your shepherd.

IV. HOW TO COME TO CHURCH (v. 4)

1. God's people are to bless His name with heart and tongue!

V. GOD IS GOOD (v. 5)

- 1. God is good to you.
- 2. God's mercy is everlasting.
- 3. His truth endures to all generations.
